Throughout the month February 2020, we carried out a gain sharing distribution (bonus), totaling Rwf 42 Million, to up to 2400 of our partner farmers in Muyongwe, Nyakibanda, Imena and Ruyumba.

As per previous years, we allocated a portion of our revenue to our farmers whose produce we managed to process and export at a generous price with the purpose of supporting and incentivizing them in remaining dedicated to the continuous improvement of the quality of their coffee
